2. Backpacking to campsite, Campers will be expected to carry everything in and out on their backs (Personal plus troop gear – no trailer). 3-1/2 miles up and over Bull Hill (rocky terrain) to site (Backpacks and Hiking Boots required).
3. **FULL** Class 'A' uniform required.
